Entry & Fee

- Complete and return your entry form to Burbank on Parade, Inc. PO Box 3396, Burbank, CA 91508-3396.
- The Selection Committee will be choosing entries that best fit our theme “Burbank on Parade Celebrates the Big Top”.
- Extra consideration will be given to those entries providing the most entertainment value. Think anything circus:
 - Clowns, acrobats, magicians, trained animals, jugglers, musicians, cyclists, etc.
- With your application, please include photos of past entries, or sketches, or diagrams, as well as full descriptions, which will help our Selection Committee visualize your entry.
- **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE PRIOR TO BEING ACCEPTED.**
- Your check will be returned to you in the event your entry is not accepted.

Awards

Awards will be presented prior to start of parade.

Rules

1. All participants must be uniformed, costumed or appropriately dressed.
2. The Parade Committee does NOT accept responsibility for false statements made by applicants or entrants.
3. **NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHT (8) WILL BE PERMITTED TO MARCH.** Younger children may ride on a float or in a vehicle.
4. All moving commercial entries including trucks, vans, floats or autos must convey the theme of the parade as well as carry the name of the sponsoring firm or organization. **ALL ENTRIES MUST SERVE A SPECIFIC PURPOSE OR BE OF ENTERTAINMENT VALUE AND CANNOT SIMPLY BE A VEHICLE WITH MINIMAL/GENERIC DECORATIONS. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE PRIOR TO BEING ACCEPTED.**
5. **FORWARD MOTION MUST BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE LINE OF THE MARCH.** All entries must comply with a no-halt format. The first violation will result in a warning from a Division Marshall or Chairman. The second violation will be recommendation for removal from this and future parades.
6. **POSITIVELY NO** throwing of candy, gum, balloons, etc. by any participant in the line of the march. Violation will result in immediate expulsion.
7. Any entries expressing political, social, or other controversial viewpoints will not be acceptable.
8. If your vehicle requires special towing equipment, i.e. tow bar, etc. parade entrant must supply such equipment. Burbank on Parade, Inc. assumes no responsibility for damages in towing.
9. Any breakdown of any unit, for any reason, may not block the progress of the parade. Towing assistance will be available.
10. In case of inclement weather, parade will go on as scheduled – please dress appropriately. In recent years it has been very hot on parade day, please dress appropriately and bring plenty of water.
11. If your unit is unable to appear, you **MUST** notify the appropriate parade Chairman (see application for contact information) as soon as possible. Any unit that does not notify the parade Chairman and fails to appear will not be accepted in future parades.
12. **NO** Mylar balloons or metallic strings.

13. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

14. PLEASE OBEY ALL PARADE MARSHALLS FROM CHECK-IN TO DISBANDING.
